

KIPP KC Dress Code

The following dress code decreases distractions to learning and promotes healthy relationships. Our Elementary and Middle School students (grades Pre-K through 8th) wear a uniform.

Endeavor Elementary and Middle School (Grades PK-8)

Uniform

- Tops: KIPP Polo, KIPP Long Sleeve*
 - Previously purchased KIPP T Shirts are acceptable; A solid color T-shirt or turtleneck may be worn <u>under</u> the polo or long sleeve; No jackets; No hoods up in the building
- Bottoms: Solid khaki bottoms or jeans
- Belts: Not required but strongly encouraged for grades 4th through 8th; Students should have their body covered from "shoulders to knees" with no undergarments visible
- No pajamas, short shorts/skirts, large rips in jeans or khakis, no sagging

Shoes

- Comfortable, supportive footwear required
- Open-toed shoes are not allowed (no Crocs, slides, slippers, etc)
- Velcro shoes are encouraged for young children who can't tie shoes

Headwear & Accessories

- No bandanas, baseball hats, bonnets, stocking caps, or durags
- Religious head covering such as Hijabs are permitted
- Footwear, jewelry, accessories, etc., must not be distracting to learning

Legacy High School (Grades 9, 10, 11)

- Students should have their body covered from "shoulders to knees"
- No crop tops, spaghetti straps, or tube tops
- No short shorts/skirts, large rips above the knee in jeans, no sagging; All shorts and skirts must pass the "fingertips test".
- No items that depict or promote gangs, violence and/or drugs
- Footwear and jewelry should not be distracting to learning
- Students in P.E. will dress down before class and will need athletic shoes
- On certain days, we ask that students dress up for school events and career opportunities, such as interviews
- If KIPP KC administrators determine that a student's clothing is distracting to the learning environment, they will be asked to either contact home or change into clothes provided by the school
